1. Our rules help us act responsibly as a community and create a safe, barrier-free and comfortable environment for study and work. We follow the law in all our activities.
2. We always represent Lapland UAS when interacting with our stakeholders. We present ourselves with decorum and our conduct is always appropriate to the situation.
3. We act responsibly and use good judgement online and in the social media.
4. Our website contains safety instructions for different situations. Participation in safety information training and drills ensures that our students and staff master the basics of everyday safety matters.
5. We practise early intervention in issues that may disrupt peaceful study or work conditions, taking the measures required by the situation. We do not condone violence, threats or inappropriate behaviour.
6. We are a drug- and alcohol-free educational institute. Possession, use and being under the influence of drugs or alcohol in learning or practical training situations are forbidden. We offer support and specialist help with substance abuse issues.
7. There is a special smoking area outdoors. Persons under 18 years are not allowed to smoke on Lapland UAS grounds.
8. We take good care of the property of Lapland UAS and practical training places. We maintain a clean work environment.
9. We observe special caution when driving near Lapland UAS and in the parking areas. We keep the emergency access roads clear.
